

Town of Spafford 2007 Memorial Day Parade Policy

General Overview: The Town of Spafford 2007 Memorial Day Parade route covers the section of Nunnery Road beginning at the Borodino Fire Hall and ending at the Veteran's Memorial, located at the intersection of Route 41 and Nunnery Road, Borodino. Walking and marching groups, animal and motorized entries, floats and other special entries are permitted to participate per the decision of the Town of Spafford 2007 Memorial Day Observance Committee. Spectators are welcome along the entire route of the parade.

The Town of Spafford 2007 Memorial Day Observance Committee has adopted the following policies concerning the Memorial Day Parade. These policies were formed with the goal of maintaining the traditional and solemn observance of Memorial Day, and to honor those who have died in service to our Nation.

1. The Town of Spafford 2007 Memorial Day Observance Committee has the exclusive right to decide which entries will be allowed to participate in the parade. No entry can participate without the written consent of the Memorial Day Observance Committee.
2. All Parade entries must be in the parade line-up area (Borodino Fire Hall parking lot) no later than 9:30 a.m., Saturday, May 26, 2007.
3. All entries must be suitable for children to view.
4. The Memorial Day Observance Committee reserves the right to refuse the participation of an entry if they believe that entry may in any way endanger participants or spectators; be considered inappropriate, obscene or libelous; create a disruption; or violate any town, state or federal regulations.
5. The Memorial Day Observance Committee retains the right to take actions necessary and proper for the removal of any animal and/or entry whose behavior becomes disruptive or dangerous.
6. Entries may not distribute printed materials, solicit funds, or gather signatures, addresses, etc. in the street to curb area along the parade route.
7. Throwing of any items (e.g., candy) is strictly forbidden along the parade route. Entries may only distribute items individually to the crowd (excepting items listed in #6).
8. NO alcoholic beverages will be permitted in the parade or parade line-up area or in any vehicles.
9. No sirens or air horns are to be blown in the parade. Riding in the back of pickup trucks is not permitted.

10. Entries may not advocate on behalf of candidates for elected office in the street-to-curb area along the parade route. Parade participants, who are elected officials, may identify themselves as such with a name tag, but may not promote their own candidacy or the candidacy of other officials for elected office during the parade or along the parade route.
